Below please find your very first affidavit of intention that you will file with your local Superintendent in the summer months prior to your first homeschooling school year. In Pittsburgh these documents must be filed during the August prior to the school year you intend to homeschool your children. It must be filed each year that you homeschool. If you live in the Pittsburgh Public School District your affidavit and objectives must be filed at:

If you live outside of the City of Pittsburgh, you should contact your local school district's superintendent office immediately to find out where you must file the paperwork and if there is a deadline. The affidavit and educational objectives below can both be filed 'as is,' or you can choose to update the objectives with your own set of educational goals and ideas. The choice is yours. This affidavit and objectives are valid for any Pennsylvania resident wishing to homeschool.

Remember that your affidavit **must** be signed in the presence of a notary and that specifics are **not** a requirement in your curriculum objectives according to Pennsylvania law.
